

OPEN ENROLLMENT

The Carlisle Local Board of Education took action March 22, 2010 to approve an open enrollment policy for the 2010-2011 school year. We will accept open enrollment students tuition-free from any school district. Based on local enrollment, we can accept a limited number of students at all grade levels. Applications will be accepted between May 1st and May 31st and will be acted upon by June 15th. Parents must then indicate acceptance of the transfer on or before June 30th. Applications may be accepted at other times of the school year at the principal's discretion.

Classroom space for these students will be based on availability on a year-to-year basis. The board will not employ additional staff to accommodate out-of-district students.

Applications shall be date stamped when received and considered on a first come, first serve basis with an assurance that (1.) Native (local) students will not be displaced. (2.) Open Enrollment students from a previous school year/term will be given preference over first-time applicants. (3.) Brothers and sisters of enrolled students will receive priority over first-time applicants.

Applicants must reapply each year to be considered. The Board does not guarantee classroom space at any grade or subject level from year to year. Once accepted, no student will be displaced during that given school year, but local enrollment levels will determine annual approval.

The Board will not alter established school bus routes to accommodate open enrollment. An open enrollment student's family may provide transportation to an established bus stop and the student may ride with local students from that point.
