

## **SCHOOL FEES POLICY**

Students are required to pay their school fees at the beginning of each school year. If the student has unpaid school fees at the end of a grading period, they will not be issued a report card and access to progress book online will be blocked.

Students are required to pay their athletic, and band transportation fees before participating in an extracurricular activity. If the student has unpaid academic school fees or unpaid transportation fees, the student will not be allowed to participate in an extracurricular activity. If a student has unpaid school fees, they may not receive a parking pass to drive to school.

Exceptions to the above policy will include students who are eligible for the 100% Federal Free Lunch subsidy (not applicable to reduced) will have their student fees waived. Parents/Guardians are required to fill out a form that establishes eligibility for free and reduced lunch, or be included on the Direct Certification list with Ohio Job and Family Services to have their student's fees waived.

Payment Plan: Students whose parent/guardian have signed a payment plan in the Treasurer's office to pay their student's school fees in installment payments acceptable to the Treasurer will be allowed to participate in extracurricular activities and receive their report cards as long as the agreed to installments are paid in a timely manner. If the agreed to installments are more than ten (10) days late, the installment plan may be forfeited at the discretion of the Treasurer and the student will lose report card and extracurricular privileges until the school fees are paid or the installment plan payments are brought current.

Payment Options: The Carlisle Local School District will make available the ability for student fees to be paid using a credit/debit card online through the School's website.
