

## Heather (Imfeld) Conger

Heather is a 1995 graduate of Carlisle High School. During her time at Carlisle High School, Heather earned varsity letters in four sports: basketball, soccer, softball, and track and field and was a member of National Honor Society. She was a four year starter in varsity basketball and is currently 2<sup>nd</sup> in career scoring with 1144 points. In 1995, Heather helped lead her team to a SWBL championship, sectional championship and district championship. In that season, Heather was selected as the girls' SWBL player of the year, and was also chosen as the District 15 player of the year. Heather was also selected for the District 15 underclassman team for two years, was the recipient of the Edna Chamberlain Award in 1995, and was nominated for the Rae Burick Women in Sports Award. Heather also had several SWBL league titles in the shot put and discus throughout her high school career and qualified for the regional track meet all four years.

Heather is currently a member of the Miami University Middletown Athletic Hall of Fame. She is currently first in scoring with 1590 points and is third in rebounding with 716 rebounds. She is also first with 155 free throws made in a season and first with 467 free throws made in a career. Heather was also chosen for the C. Eugene Bennett Scholar Athlete of the Year three times and was the recipient of the Lynn Darbyshire Warrior Award.

Heather has been a math teacher at Chamberlain Middle School for fifteen years and has also coached junior high girls basketball, JV girls basketball, and junior high track and field for several years. She resides in Carlisle with her husband, Mike, and their two children, Drew and Ally.
