Driving to school/ drop off/ pick up,

On the back of this sheet is a diagram that will explain the procedure we have put in place for driving, dropping off, and picking up your student in the morning and afternoon. We feel this is most efficient and can make the process quicker and safer for everyone. We understand mornings and evenings are hectic, but we must consider the safety of our students and the value of your car. Here are some rules to go by in the morning and evening:

- 1) Everyone (pick up or drop off) must follow the new access road that is the first right into the parking lot (someone will be guiding you as you enter the lot).
- 2) Everyone must stay single file. If there is space between you and the next car please pull forward to allow more cars to drop off/pick up at one time. Do not drop off at the main entrance sidewalk into the Jr./Sr. High School if there is space between you and the next car. Pull forward until you reach the next parked car. This will allow more students to be released/picked up.
- 3) After you have dropped/picked up your student, use the exit lane to the left. This will be an exit lane only.
- 4) Please follow the signs when exiting. Please understand HS students that drive will cross in front of exiting cars at the end of the exiting lane (someone will be there to stop traffic).
- 5) No one will be allowed to exit cars until 7am and dismissal will be at 2pm in the afternoon. Student drivers will be dismissed at 1:58pm to get student drivers moving.
- 6) Students getting dismissed for pickups will wait on the sidewalk in from of the building. Students will not be allowed to start walking off campus until notified by school personnel.
- 7) Please be patient. This will not be perfect at the beginning of the school year.
