OVERVIEW

The Carlisle Local School District has been allocated \$1,511,063.02 for its ARP ESSER funding. The District's intended use of these funds are set forth in the following items.

PROPOSED ITEMS:

- **Facilities:**
 - Investing in resources to implement CDC's K-12 operational strategy for in-person learning and remote learning. In person learning can require the need to increase spacing. We have to be able to maintain CDC recommended spacing.
 - Investing in resources to implement CDC's K-12 operational strategy for in-person learning to keep educators, staff, and students safe;
 - Improving ventilation and obtaining additional space if needed to ensure social distancing in classrooms. Improved physical environment with cleaner air
 - Expanded instructional capacity

- **Transportation:**
 - The district has many needs and the difficulty to get students transported is one of them, we are reviewing our assets and quantities needed to meet the spacing needs.
