



The **Home Energy Assistance Winter Crisis Program** provides eligible Warren County residents assistance with a one-time payment with a disconnection, needing to establish new service, pay to transfer service, may assist with a Percentage of Income Payment Plan (PIPP) default, pay first PIPP or have 25% or less of bulk fuel/propane.

The Low-Income Household Water Assistance Program is available. This is a one-time payment towards a disconnection, needing to establish new service or transfer of service of your water or wastewater bill.

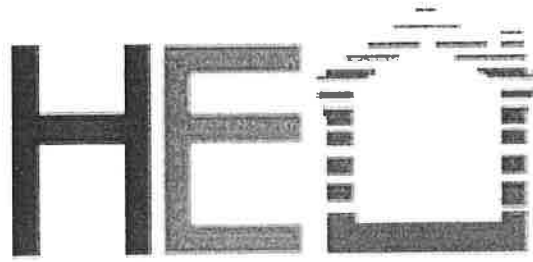
