Several Road Closures for At-Grade Railroad Crossings.

Lebanon, Ohio – Franklin Township and City of Carlisle, Warren County, Ohio – The following roads will be closed beginning Tuesday, September 6, 2022, for the replacement of the railroad ties and resurfacing at each crossing. This project is being performed by a Contractor for CSX Railroad Transportation.

Beginning September 6, 2022, Franklin-Madison Road (Franklin Township) will be closed at the at-grade railroad crossing for two (2) to three (3) days, weather permitting.

When Franklin-Madison Road closure is complete, the Contractor shall close Central Avenue (City of Carlisle) at the at-grade railroad crossing for two (2) to three (3) days, weather permitting.

When Central Avenue closure is complete, the Contractor shall close Fairview Avenue (City of Carlisle) at the atgrade railroad crossing for two (2) to three (3) days, weather permitting.

When Fairview Avenue closure is complete, the Contractor shall close Union Road (City of Carlisle) at the atgrade railroad crossing for two (2) to three (3) days, weather permitting.

There will be no posted detour for each closure.
