Dear Parents and Students,

It's time to begin planning our annual tour to Washington, D.C. Tour dates this year are **Wednesday - Saturday, November 15 - 18, 2023.** This is an excellent opportunity for students to visit the hub of our American heritage and government. Our staff will chaperone the tour, which will be arranged by Classic Student Tours, a local agency that specializes in Educational Student Travel Programs and has been coordinating tours since 1985.

A Classic Student Tours representative will conduct a brief informational meeting and presentation at the school on **Tuesday, April 18, 2023 at 6:00 PM.** All interested students and their parents should attend this meeting so that questions regarding this travel opportunity can be answered. Any payments not received by the final due date will need to be in the form of a cashier's check, money order, or credit card. Invoices <u>will not</u> be individually mailed for payments; however, announcements will be made to students at school to inform them of pertinent information they need to relay home. Special payment arrangements can be made upon request.

On <u>SEPTEMBER 12, 2023, ALL ACCOUNTS MUST BE CURRENT</u> (including payment arrangements made through the tour company), or participants will be removed from the trip until accounts are brought current. If a participant is removed from the trip due to a delinquent account, the participant will be placed on a waiting list until the account is brought current. Seat availability is not guaranteed, as his/her spot will be filled with a student from the waiting list, if one exists. Additionally, all refund policies are in effect.

This tour will be educational, interesting, and fun! Visiting the most influential city in the world, our nation's capital, will be remembered as a highlight of each student's junior high school experience.
