

Legal Notice Regarding Available Federal Funds (Part B)

Dear Parents and Community Members,

The Carlisle Local School District receives federal Special Education Part B IDEA (Individuals with Disabilities Education Act) funds to assist with the education of students with disabilities. This money can only be used for students with disabilities ages 3 to 21 who are on an Individual Education Plan (IEP) and for Coordinated Early Intervening Services. The amount of federal Special Education funding is determined by the number of students with disabilities in each school district. Formerly titled Title VI-B and Early Childhood funds, the new funding procedure is called the Special Education – Part B IDEA money.

Currently the District uses these funds to provide Special Education Intervention Specialist Teachers to work with students with disabilities.
